The City Council established the Senior Citizen Advisory Committee, primarily to advise the Parks, Recreation and Social Services Commission on matters relating to senior citizen programs and needs in the City of Lawndale. The committee consists of seniors who are 55 years of age or older and either (a) reside within the city of Lawndale; or (b) participate in the City's senior citizen program and reside in the South Bay.

The committee meets once per month and serves without compensation.
